(First party and Second party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party') as

WHERE AS:

A) First Party is a Higher Educational Institution named:

(I) **K.G.D.M. Arts, Commerce and Science College, Niphad, Dist. Nashik - 422 303.**

B) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.

C) The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training, Education and Research.

D) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.

E) - **S.K. Oyster Mushroom Farm** -, the Second Party is engaged in Business, Manufacturing, Skill Development, Education and R&D Services in the fields of - **Mushroom**.

F) -**S.K. Oyster Mushroom Farm** -, the Second Party is promoted by promoter, **S.K. Oyster Mushroom Farm** engaged in the business of training of Mushroom Manufacturing, Organic farming, and composting technology.

S.K. Oyster Mushroom Farm, Chandori, it has training centre at Chandori, Nashik, they are engaged in the scientific Mushroom Farming, imparting practical training in Mushroom Cultivation, encouraging applied research and extension activities in Mushroom Manufacturing.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MoU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1

CO-OPERATION

1.1. Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.



1.2. First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching / training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the Second Party.

1.3. The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall co-operate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents' as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede and prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof).

CLAUSE 2

SCOPE OF THE MoU

2.1. The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.

2.2. **Curriculum Design:** Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching / training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.

2.3. **Industrial Training & Visits:** Industry and Institution interaction will give an insight in to the latest developments / requirements of the industries; the Second Party to permit the Faculty and Students of the First Party to visit its group companies.

2.4. **Skill Development Programs:** Second Party to train the students of First Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.

2.5. **Guest Lectures:** Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lecturers to the students of the First Party on the technology trends and in house requirements.

2.6. **Placement of Trained Students:** Second Party will actively engage to help the delivery of the training and placement of students of the First Party into internships/jobs; and will facilitate placements the students. The Second Party will itself absorb of the trained students as per the available jobs

2.7. Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programs on the terms specified herein.

2.8. There is no financial commitment on the part of the K.G.D.M. Arts, Commerce and Science College, the First Party to take up any programme mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

CLAUSE 3

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

3.1. Nothing contained in this MoU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

CLAUSE 4

VALIDITY

4.1. This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period, S.K. Oyster Mushroom Farm, the Second Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MoU. Any act on the part of Training Partner or S.K.

Oyster Mushroom Farm, the Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MoU.

4.2. For academic year 2019-2020-2020-2021 to 2021-2022 both Parties may terminate this MoU upon 30 calendar days notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

CLAUSE 5

RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

5.1. It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MoU as independent contractors and the relationship established under this MoU shall not be construed as partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any way to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MoU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.





The programme was introduced by Dr.R.N. Bhavare sir (Principal K.G.D.M. College Niphad) and chief guest Mr. VijayShirsath (Mushroom cultivation trainer), Dr.R.N. Parmar (IQAC Co-Ordinator).in this programme Dr.R.N. Bhavare explained how mushroom is important for human beings.He said that the main object of mushroom cultivation is you can earn yourself.

In this programme 1st of all Mr. VijayShirsath delivered the lecture on topic mushroom, types of mushroom, importance of mushroom and how to cultivates the mushroom at home.in his lecture he spoke about the concept of mushroom i.e. "*A mushroom is the reproductive structure produced by some fungi. It is somewhat like the fruit of a plant, except that the seeds*". He also told the diseases developed on mushroom bed. There are two types of mold generally occurs on mushroom beds-1) Black Molds 2) Green Molds.After that he told the medicinal and economic importance of the mushroom for human beings. nutritional value of edible mushrooms is due to their high protein, fibre, vitamin and mineral contents, and low-fat levels.Mushrooms act as antibacterial, immune system enhancer and cholesterol lowering agents, Mushrooms may help keep you young, it protects your brain as you age, Mushrooms can help your heart health, it also helps give you energy. At the last session of programme Shirsath sir start his training programme with substrate filling. Step by step he was trained students. SpawnProduction, CompostPreparation, Spawning, SpawnRunning, Casing, Fruiting.

With this all-step training was over. Vijay sir distributes the spawn to the students to try the mushroom cultivation at home.

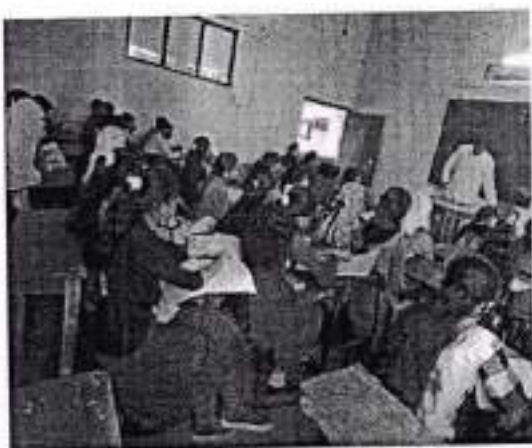
